About the Hospital

Dr. Nair's Hospital was started as a small clinic by Dr. K.P. Nair FRCS on 5th December 1968. The hospital was started with definite aims such as to provide a clean residence for the patients, to maintain a high standard in patient care and to practice the art of medicine without deviating from scientific method. Briefly, the aim of the hospital is primarily to help the patient recover from the disease. The inscription in Sanskrit in the hospital emblem "Shariramadhyam Khalu Dharmasadhanam" means that a healthy body is the first requisite for the pursuit of Dharma and thus to greatness in life. The inscription is taken from Kalidasa's Kumara Sambhavam.

Today Dr. Nair's Hospital is an ISO 9001-2008 certified 300 bed multi speciality hospital.

The School was started in the year 1994.

The first batch of students was admitted in January 1994.

Curriculum

The course of study emphasizes the scientific principles, the theory of caring and the concepts essential in providing holistic patient care. The theory is closely co-related with practical experience. The course primarily prepares the student to provide comprehensive nursing care with high level competence to all patients requiring their services. The duration of the course is three years starting on 1st October every year.

Eligibility

Candidates for admission to the course should satisfy the following general requirements.

- A pass in Plus Two examination or its equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional subjects with an aggregate of 40% marks. In the absence of candidates with the above qualification, a pass in plus two examinations or its equivalent with any other group as optional subjects with an aggregate mark of 40% can be considered. In the case of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates a pass in Plus Two or its equivalent examination for Physics, Chemistry and Biology is sufficient.
- Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government.
- Registered ANM
- 10+2 Vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
- 10+2 Health care Science Vocational stream from a recognized CBSE board/State/Centre.
- For foreign nationals 12th standard will be obtained by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi.
- Female Candidates not less than 17 years or not more than 35 years as on the 31st of December of the year. For ANM/LHV, there is no age bar.
- Students shall be medically fit.
- Admission of students shall be once in a year.
- For disabled candidates: 3% Disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for admission should be made in the prescribed form in duplicate. One copy should be submitted duly filled in and with all enclosures mentioned below to "The Director, School of Nursing, Dr. Nair's Hospital, Kollam - 691002". The duplicate duly filled in and with all enclosures, should be sent to "The

Registrar, Kerala Nurse's & Midwives Council, Red Cross Road, Thiruvananthapuram - 35". The following documents should be forwarded

along with the Application form duly signed and filled in the candidate's own hand writing. Incomplete application will be rejected.

- True copy of second page of SSLC book to prove age
- True copy of SSLC mark list
- True copy of Higher Secondary Examination or Equivalent Certificate
- True copy of Higher Secondary Examination Mark list
- Income & Community Certificate from Village Officer for candidates eligible for reservation
- Conduct Certificate from the head of institution from which the candidate completes qualifying examination

Admission

Admission will be on the basis of merit. The total percentage of marks secured in the qualifying examination, optional Subjects of other group plus the marks obtained by candidates in the interview will be considered.

Residence

All selected candidates have to join the hostel provided. Mess expenses are divided among the hostel inmates.

Discipline

Selected candidates should strictly follow all instructions from the school authorities for maintaining discipline and decorum of the school and hospital. Mobile phone is strictly prohibited. If found it will be confiscated and fine imposed.

Ragging is strictly Prohibited

As per record of proceedings of Supreme Court of Indian section XI A item No. 45 dated 10-12-2007, if any incident of Ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if her explanation is not found satisfactory the authority will expel her from the Institution. The onus of proof is on the accused. During the course of study the students should not join in any organizations / associations other than Student Nurse's Association.

Violation of the above conditions will be liable for disciplinary action.

Uniform

Uniform will be provided by the school at minimum cost. All students should wear regulation uniforms during their course as well as period of practical training.
